Kick Starter Programme candidate commenced 16<sup>th</sup> September 2021 Interviews are due to commence shortly for an Administrative Assistant (Maternity Cover) One of the caretakers has reduced their hours to 24 per week from 30.

6. 2021/22 STAFFING BUDGET UPDATE

The National pay rise for staff is still being finalised but the offer is an increase of 2.75% for scale 1 (this affects one employee) and 1.75% for all other scales. This would be back dated to  $1^{st}$  April 2021. The Town Clerk when preparing the budget for this year predicted 2% so there is no effect on the current budget resolved by Council.

The resolved staffing cost for 2021/22 is  $\pounds$ 286,000. However, based on the staffing update, this figure is now expected to decrease to  $\pounds$ 282,750.

7. 2022/23 STAFFING BUDGET

This budget is based on the following recommendations: Town Clerk working hours reduced to 30 per week Senior Caretaker moves 2 incremental points based on an outstanding appraisal review Maternity cover provided Kick Starter programme candidate awarded permanent contract HR support contract extended 1 additional Caretaker employed on 30 hours Employers National Insurance increase covered National pay rise of 2% forecasted
