6. 2021/22 STAFFING BUDGET UPDATE

Following the last meeting, various staff changes took place unexpectedly. The staffing budget update is as follows but does not include the National pay rise for staff which is still being negotiated (2.75% for scale 1 and 1.75% for all other scales).

At the February 2022 meeting, the Town Clerk will be making a recommendation that any underspends are added to the Earmarked Reserve for Salaries to account for the backdated wages that will need to be made in relation to the pay award.

7. NATIONAL LIVING WAGE INCREASE APRIL 2022

The National Living wage with effect from 1st April 2022 will increase to £9.50 per hour from £8.91 per hour.

The existing pay spine currently pays SCP1 at £9.27 per hour but this will increase by 2.75% with the pay award and thereafter the rate will be £9.52 per hour. This will meet the National Living Wage rise. The lowest pay spine scale that any member of staff is on is currently SCP2 and this rate will increase to £9.62 per hour when the pay rise is agreed. The pay rise will be backdated to 1^{st} April 2021.
