129 LEIGH HALL ROAD, LEIGH-ON-SEA, SS9 1QY (Elms Ward)

Demolish existing bungalow and erect a pair of semi-detached dwellinghouses and lay out hardstanding.

Objection

The proposal is an overdevelopment of this site.

It would also result in the loss of a traditional bungalow which is contrary to Leigh-on-Sea Town Council's general policy.

Erect single storey side and rear extension, alter side and rear elevation to first floor (Amended Proposal).

Erect single storey side and rear extension to form dwellinghouse and entrance to self-contained flat at first floor, extend existing vehicular crossover on to Lord Roberts Avenue and layout parking to rear.

Alter existing porch to front, layout access ramp, steps, paving, boundary walls and garden area to front and alter existing ground floor side window.

There is no objection to the proposed new ramp.

Objection

The Committee do however object to the removal of the original existing feature doors and windows which will alter the appearance of the frontage of the Church.
