6. CONFIDENTIAL 'PROTOCOL ON MEMBER/OFFICER RELATIONS' MATTER

It was highlighted that it was inappropriate for all Councillors to take part in the confidential item. This was disputed. The Chairman of the Committee advised members that the Chairman of Council had already submitted the formal Code of Conduct complaints to the Monitoring Officer. Some members indicated that this was not in accordance with the member/officer protocol nor the external professional Human Resources (HR) advice read out by the Vice Chairman of the Committee.

As the complaints had been forwarded to the Monitoring Officer, the Staffing Committee were unable to follow the procedure of 5.3 under the Member/Officer Protocol and the HR guidance and were unable to consider making a recommendation to Council for the complaints to be submitted by Council (as a whole).

The Committee **RESOLVED** that the Vice-Chairman of the Staffing Committee would check on the Staff member's welfare to ensure they feel supported at this time.
