At its meeting 22nd June 2021, this Committee resolved to make a request to SBC for a formal investigation/assessment to be undertaken by an engineer to determine if a TRO could be applied in the area by the Skate Park at Leigh Marshes (minute 12). A response was finally received 26th November advising that the road past the skate park is not public highway but classified as a public open space. This means that a legally enforceable speed limit cannot be installed. The Town Clerk asked if Leigh Town Council would be therefore be able to install speed awareness signs along the skate park frontage and this was confirmed possible as long as it is within the area covered by the skate park lease and doesn't cause damage or danger. Arrangements are therefore being made to mount smaller signs (30 cm x 40 cm) to the floodlight columns as follows in both directions:
